Very often it has been coming to the notice of the undersigned that though bills for 40% T.M.F. are being submitted by the concerned Addl. Public Prosecutors/Spl. Public Prosecutors but the disposed briefs whereon the claim of amount are based are not returned to the office.

It has been the common practice to return the briefs of disposed cases and to claim the bill on that basis. It is to be kept in mind that briefs are allotted to the A.P.Ps/Spl. P.Ps. by the office and they make appearances on that basis, thus the entire claim of the payable amount hinges upon the allotment and disposal.

Office needs to verify the claim made and it is to be done on the basis of records. Disposed briefs are one of the relevant records for the said purpose.

Hence, all the Addl. Public Prosecutors/Spl. Public Prosecutors are hereby requested to return the disposed briefs while submitting their bill(s) of 40% T.M.F.

2- The office is hereby directed to ensure the compliance of the above direction and to receive the 40% T.M.F. bills when disposed cases briefs are submitted by the concerned A.P.Ps/Spl. A.P.Ps.


3- This order shall come into effect immediately.
